This half term our Curriculum Topic is:

We will be finding out about what climate change is and what impact it is has on our planet. We will also be thinking about what we can do to help stop the impact of climate change.

Please remember to read with your child at home as regularly as possible.


Practice your times tables.

Our Art and Design projects will involve creating art work that represents nature and the impacts of global warming/climate change. Along with this the children will be looking into comic book style art and creating their own pieces. We will use the previous techniques we have learnt to create a range of images.

During literacy we will be learning all about the story 'The Great Kapok Tree' by Lynne Cherry and the children will be writing their own stories with climate change as their theme. We will also be completing work based on the book 'The Vanishing Rainforest' by Richard Platt which will see the children writing a piece of persuasive text.



Our Science focus this half term will be living things and their habitats and conservation. We will be researching the impact climate change is having on habitats and different climate zones.



It is going to be a packed half term. You can help support your child in school by reading with them as often as you can, talking to them about what they have been learning about in class and helping them to learn their times tables.
